SPOT THE SPIRIT!

As we read the book of Acts throughout the season of Easter, we will be learning about how the Holy Spirit spread throughout the world. Over countless miles, through all different types of people, and in little and big ways, the Holy Spirit touched lives and transformed the way people thought about God and faith.
